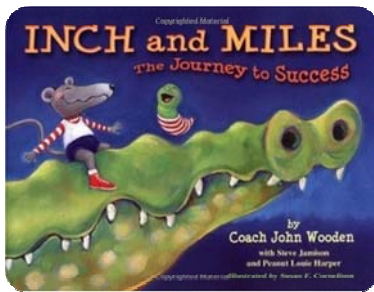


HILTON NORTHWOOD 5TH
